Caregivers Caring for Patient with Confirmed COVID-19 Case		Wear N95	Wear protective eyewear	Wear gown & gloves

Confirmed (COVID-19 Test positive):

- Caregiver: **N95 Mask**, protective eyewear, gown and gloves
- Patient Placement (ICU or Floor): Move to 10-200 in Airborne infection isolation room (if available)

Suspected Case (COVID-19 Test pending):

- Caregiver: Face mask, protective eyewear, gown and gloves
- Patient Placement (ICU or Floor): No routine need for airborne isolation room (AIR) unless aerosol producing procedure anticipated
